



Thornycroft, Basingstoke's major employer for some 60 years, manufactured some 60,000 military and commercial vehicles seen in the 1915 picture below:



More pictures were previously displayed at Morrisons Supermarket café, built on top of this factory, est. 1898 closed 1972.

In September 1913 the firm Messrs Thornycroft wrote to the Council complaining they were having difficulty in employing married men owing to the want of houses! We need more focus and a return to local manufacturing and services in Basingstoke to mitigate against climate change and insure against global economy boom and bust cycles.
