

Friends Of Loddon Vale **Parks**



The white chalky substance in the Brookvale Brook came from the balancing pond beside Wicks. When dug out the issue stopped.



Allium Purple Sensation are delicious & compact lollipops of pure purple from a bulbous herbaceous perennial up to 90cm. A strong onion or garlic scent, with linear strap-shaped/cylindrical basal leaves having star-shaped or bell-shaped flowers in an umbel on a leafless stem. Easy to grow in full sun/sheltered position/chalk/clay/ sand/loam with no pruning. The Friends met the Council's Operations Team who drew up a management plan for Victory Park shown below. The Operations Team have the heavy tools and plant to tackle the big jobs of designated mowing areas. clearing the brook and preventing trees and bushes from crowding out other plants. Development SubCtte

Met recently to progress local issues and review several papers regarding population and resources.

The affordable housing in Brook House was traded off elsewhere. Building on the May St Garages should provide 100% social housing in return for putting another estimated 28 cars onto Lower Brook Street.

Evidence papers are being submitted to the Planning Inspector regarding the local plan housing numbers and need.

With the customary higher number of units being demanded, this will aggravate the pressure on the existing infrastructure in urgent need of Tinkering with the upgrading. roundabouts is unlikely to make the big difference needed.

Your town MP requested more money for roads, but Water, Sewerage, Electric, Gas and Broadband will also need to be expanded. This is unlikely to be paid for by the Developers and so will continue to degrade Air, Water, Soil, Biodiversity with increasing pollution.

We submitted another request to the Planning Inspector to assess the Environmental Impact of the Councils' Development appraisals which only address development fundability/siting.

No movement yet on the Pumping Station and Saunders Field.

BCA Bygones

Alexandra Road Shops

This old shopfront has been revealed during building works in Alexandra Road...



But who were Littleiohns and Q Neville? We did a bit of research and discovered that the cottages and shop were built in 1903 by Mussellwhite and by 1907 Mrs Gertrude Gwinnell had a stationery shop here. But by 1911, Agnes Mary Sparkes was the shopkeeper. The Sparkes family appear to have come to Basingstoke because Henry Sparkes had a railway job - he was a railway guard living in Phoenix Park Terrace in the 1891 census but he had been a grocer when they married in 1875. The shop then passed to their daughter Sarah who married a Fred Neville who was a post office worker, Sarah's sister, Ellen married Oliver Littlejohns in 1900 but she and her daughter were living with the Nevilles by 1911. In turn, Fred and Sarah had a daughter Queenie Neville, born 1912 and the shop was theirs until the mid 1930s.
