

Leisure Park Future

This is moving forward with possible improvements including padel tennis, active leisure, health and fitness facilities, indoor golf, cinemas and even waterparks. Also possibly a multi-use sports and events arena. There may be an opportunity to give the public more access to Saunders Field as an eco-conservation zone and a more informal green open space. Any proposals for this will respect its importance to the borough for biodiversity and flood alleviation.

Where is Foulflood Lane?

The lane is shown on this 1762 map:



and the first document, from 1709, is the Bolton estates renting a "close called Foulflood, to George Thorp of Basingstoke, Goldsmith"

It seems that this was a wealthy family, clothiers, glovers and vintners too, owning land in Worting, Church Street and Winklebury Ring.

In 1802 the land passed to the Smith family, and in 1841 to the Greene family – of Paris!

The first record of house building is new bungalow for Miss E L F Jewell in 1925, and by 1928, 'The Beeches', was in Foulflood Lane. for F G Selway.

Flood? Yes it did, often. The name has been changed, but the 1762 map ancient footpath is still there:
